Erasmus+ BIP Framework

- Short-term blended mobility (physical + virtual component)
 - Minimum 3 HEIs from 3 Programme Countries
 - Minimum 3 ECTS awarded
 - Minimum 15 funded participants
 - Added value beyond existing courses

 - From manuscript to digital pipeline
 - Creating a European academic network
 - Beyond mobility: building a research laboratory

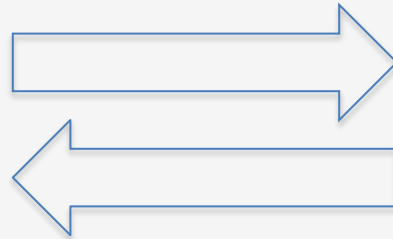
Programme Architecture

- Online Preparatory Phase (Collaborative Learning)
 - Onsite Intensive Week in Patmos (5 days)
 - Integrated Classical ↔ Digital Approach
 - Minimum 3 ECTS recognition

Institutional Framework (DUTH)

- Approval by Department General Assembly
 - Submission to Erasmus+ Office
 - Evaluation by Erasmus+ Committee
 - Funding through IKY allocation
 - Transparent selection criteria

Academic Structure

- Morning: Classical Palaeography (Manuscripts, Codicology, Textual Criticism)
- Afternoon: Digital Methods (HTR, TEI/XML, ML, Stemmatology)
- Parallel workshops (2-3 groups)
- Cultural and community-building activities

Role of the Coordinating Institution (DUTH)

- Programme design and academic coordination
 - Submission and institutional approval
 - Hosting and onsite organisation
 - Certification and reporting
 - Ensuring compliance with Erasmus+ rules

Role of Partner Institutions

- Teaching contribution (lectures/workshops)
 - Student selection and ECTS recognition
 - Grant agreements and funding management
 - Participation in long-term collaboration
